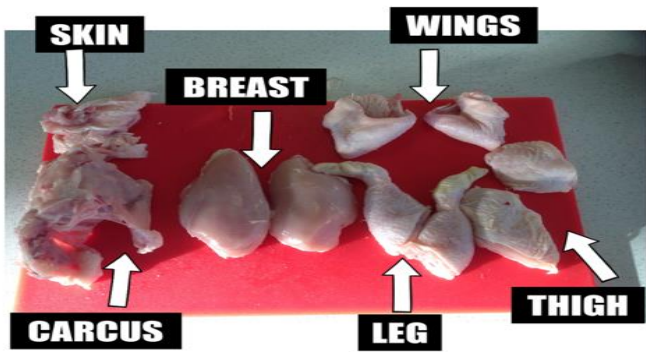

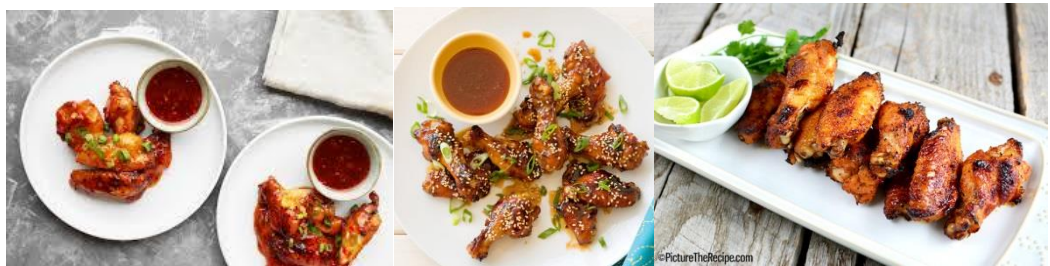
### 10B 9.1.24 CHICKEN JOINTING

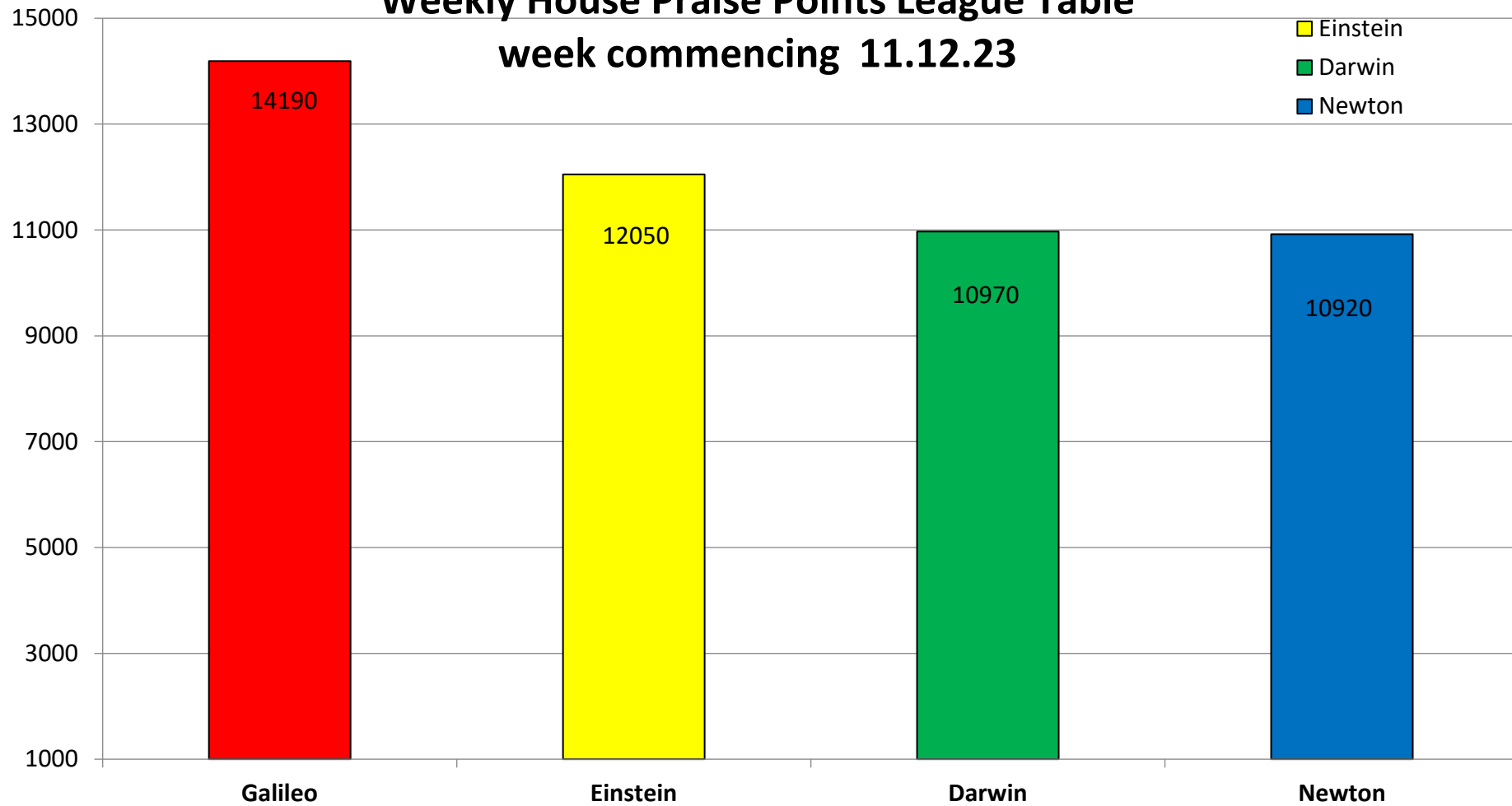
