



# Tilly Hutton (10GSWI) has been selected to play for the U18 England Volleyball Team!

Tilly started playing volleyball about 3 years ago. She started training with South Hants' Junior Volleyball Club and regularly plays for the U15 and U16 teams. This season she helped them to secure a place in the U15 National Last 8 Competition, finishing 5<sup>th</sup>. In 2022, Tilly was selected to play for the U15 South East England Team, and in 2023 she captained the U15 girls' in the National Inter-Regional competition and made it to the finals. In November 2022 she trialled for the England Cadets and was successful. She has been training regularly with the squad over the last 18 months which involves regular journeys to and from the National Volleyball Centre based in Kettering. To further develop her potential, she now trains and plays in the Women's National League Division 1 for Southampton Volleyball Club as their youngest player, which has included matches as far away as Stockport and Liverpool.

Through her hard work and commitment, she has recently been selected to play for the England U18 Volleyball Team in the European Junior qualifiers. This event takes place in Spain between the 12th and 14th April 2024, they play Germany, Spain and Estonia for a place in European Championship finals later this year. Congratulations Tilly!

- 63 g unsalted butter
- 50 g light brown sugar
- 50 g white granulated sugar
- 1 medium egg
- 1/2 tsp vanilla extract
- 13 g cocoa powder
- 113 g plain flour
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp bicarbonate of soda
- 1/4 tsp baking powder
- 75 g white chocolate chips
- 75 g milk chocolate chips

#### **MERINGUE - 10B - 26.3.24**

PLEASE BRING IN THE INGREDIENTS SHOWN BELOW AND A CONTAINER. THIS WILL BE KEPT TO USE ON THE 27.3.24 PRACTICAL.

#### **INGREDIENTS TO MAKE MERINGUE:**

1 Egg white 60g caster sugar



#### **METHOD TO MAKE MERINGUE:**

Heat oven to 170c/gas 3 and line a large baking tray with parchment paper. Whisk the egg white in a clean bowl using an electric whisk until they reach stiff peaks, then add the sugar in 3 lots, re-whisking to stiff peaks every time. Spoon dollops of the mixture onto the baking parchment, cook in the oven for about 30mins- 1 hour until the meringues are completely hard and come off the paper easily.

#### 10B 27.3.24 -ETON MESS AND STRAWBERRY COULIS

INGREDIENTS YOU WILL NEED TO BRING IN TO LESSON:

250g strawberries 100g caster sugar 225ml double cream (MUST NOT BE ELMLEA OR ANY OTHER CREAM ALTERNATIVE)

1/2 tbsp icing sugar (Meringue you made in Tuesdays lesson.)

Place 200g strawberries into a saucepan with the caster sugar. Set over a medium heat, crushing with the back of a fork until the sugar has dissolved and the strawberries have become saucy. Taste and add a little more sugar if strawberries are particularly sharp. Strain through a sieve, then chill until ready to serve.

In a large bowl whisk the cream with the icing sugar until it just holds its shape. Chop up your remaining strawberries. Roughly crush ¾ of the meringues and tip them in with the chopped strawberries and stir, then swirl through the strawberry coulis. Dollop into a bowl then crush the remaining meringues, sprinkling the pieces over the top'

#### Message from Mrs Walsh to Galileo House


Dear Galileo families.
