

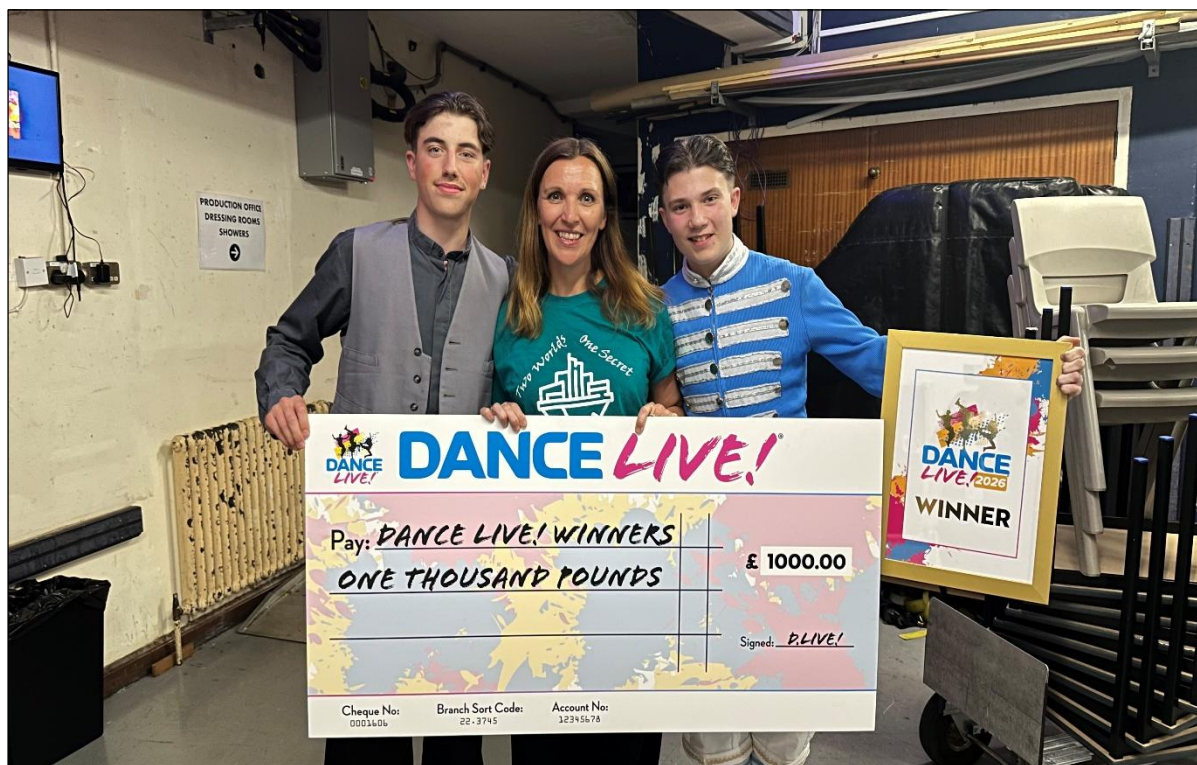

### Fruit tarts




**METHOD**

1. Preheat the oven to 190C.
2. Add the butter, flour and icing sugar into a bowl. Using your fingertips, lightly rub together the fat and the flour together so it resembles breadcrumbs.
3. Add the egg yolk and mix so it resembles a firm dough. If dry, add a tsp of water.
4. Roll out the dough and cut around the dish leaving a lip to allow the pastry to shrink into the dish when pressed.
5. Add the pastry to the tray and put in the oven for 25 minutes or until crisp and golden brown.
6. Fill with custard and chopped fruit to decorate.

**Ingredients**  
 150g/3oz butter  
 150g/3oz flour  
 100g/3.5oz icing sugar  
 1 egg yolk  
 100g/3.5oz custard  
 Fruit to decorate

### SWEET PIN WHEELS




**METHOD**

1. Preheat oven to 220C fan/gas mark 7
2. Place dry ingredients into a bowl, add in the butter and rub together to create breadcrumbs
3. Slowly add the water in to the mix using a spoon to make a soft but not sticky dough.
4. Turn onto a floured surface and knead for 10 minutes
5. Roll into a square roughly 25cm x 25 cm making sure the edges are straight
6. Spread your sauce over the dough and add toppings, not too many or they will burst out
7. Roll it like a swiss roll, tucking the edge in first and rolling up together, then cut into 9 equal sections and place onto a greased baking tray.
8. Cover and leave in a warm place to rise or until they have doubled in size
9. Bake for 15 - 20 minutes until golden brown

**Ingredients**  
 200g Strong White flour  
 Extra flour for dusting  
 1 packet of yeast  
 1 tsp of sugar  
 15g Butter  
 125ml warm water  
 Biscuits or choc spread

### SCONES




**METHOD**

1. Heat the oven to 220C/200C fan/425F and place a lined baking tray in the oven to preheat.
2. Tip the flour, salt, baking powder and butter into a bowl and rub together until it resembles bread crumbs. Pour the milk into a bowl and stir in the sugar and add alternative ingredients.
3. Alternatively, add the butter into the flour mixture till breadcrumbs are formed. Add the lemon juice to the dry mixture!
4. Heat the Milk in the microwave or on the hob so its warm but not hot - microwave will take about 30 seconds - you don't want it too hot!
5. Add the vanilla to the milk and mix.
6. Make a well in the dry mixture and add the liquid - stir with a spatula as it will be very wet at first - but it's soon dry out as the liquid is incorporated.
7. Dust the work surface with some flour and tip the dough onto it - fold the dough over a few times so it is smooth but do not over work it!
8. Roll the dough out till it is about 1cm thick.
9. Dip a scone mould/cutter into the spare flour and cut out the scones - you will probably get four out of the first get! Repeat this again till you finish up all the dough!
10. Take the tray out of the oven carefully and place the scones onto it - brush the tops with the beaten egg so its glazed and bake in the oven for 10 minutes - leave to cool slightly when baked.

**Ingredients**  
 142g Unsalted Butter (cold/cubed)  
 1/2 tsp Baking Powder  
 175g Self-Rising Flour (plus extra for dusting)  
 25g Caster Sugar  
 1/2 tsp Lemon Juice  
 100ml Milk  
 1/2 tsp Vanilla Extract  
 1 Egg (to glaze)  
 40g additional ingredients

### MAC, VEG 'N CHEESE




**METHOD**

1. Bring a saucepan of water to the boil, and then add the macaroni. Cook for about 10-12 minutes, until al dente. The frozen veg/olives 5 mins before the end.
2. Grate the cheese.
3. While the pasta is cooking make the sauce:
  - place the fat, flour and milk into a small saucepan.
  - bring the sauce to a boil, whisking all the time until it has thickened.
  - stir in 20g of the grated cheese and mustard or mustard powder.
  - simmer for 2-3 mins.
4. Preheat the grill.
5. Drain the boiling hot water away from the macaroni using a colander over a sink.
6. Stir the macaroni into the cheese sauce and add a few handfuls of black pepper.
7. Pour the macaroni into a foil tray/dish.
8. Sprinkle the remaining cheese over the top.
9. Place under a hot grill until the cheese is bubbling and golden brown.

**Ingredients**  
 100g Macaroni  
 100g frozen mixed veg  
 40g Cheddar Cheese  
 25g Butter  
 25g Plain flour  
 250ml Semi-Skimmed Milk  
 Black Pepper  
 1 tsp Mustard or Mustard Powder

### YORKSHIRE PUDDINGS




**METHOD**

1. Heat oven to 230C/fan 210C/gas 8.
2. Grease a little sunflower oil evenly into Yorkshire pudding tins and place in the oven to heat through.
3. To make the batter, tip 100g plain flour into a bowl and beat in 2 eggs until smooth.
4. Gradually add 100ml milk and carry on beating until the mix is completely lump-free. Season with salt and pepper.
5. Pour the batter into a jug, then remove the hot tins from the oven. Carefully and evenly pour the batter into the holes.
6. Place the tins back in the oven and leave undisturbed for 20-25 mins until the puddings have puffed up and browned.

**Ingredients**  
 70g plain flour  
 2 eggs (200ml/7fl oz)  
 100ml milk  
 sunflower oil, for cooking

### SCOTCH EGGS



**METHOD PLEASE BEARING IN 3 READY COOKED BOILED EGGS**

1. Put 3 eggs into a pan of cold water and bring to the boil. Boil for about 4 minutes, then transfer to a bowl of cold water. Once cooled carefully peel them.
2. Squeeze the sausages out of their skins into a bowl.
3. Finely chop the herbs and add to the sausage meat along with the grated nutmeg, the mustard and a pinch of salt and pepper. Give it a good mix then divide into 3 balls.
4. Have 3 plates ready one with flour, one with the 2 remaining eggs (beat them together first), and the other with the breadcrumbs on.
5. Start by flattening your hands, then in the palm of one hand, flatten one of the sausage balls into an oval shaped Patis.
6. Roll an egg into the flour, then pop into the middle of the patty gently shaping the meat around the egg, moulding it with your hands until sealed.
7. Roll the veg/pep into the flour, then the beaten eggs, then the breadcrumbs. Roll in to the egg and breadcrumbs - again for a good coating.
8. Fry the eggs in hot oil for around 5 minutes until golden brown and cooked through. Remove with a slotted spoon and drain on kitchen paper to remove excess oil.
9. Coat the scotch eggs slightly then place on a plate with salad garnish to present.

**Ingredients**  
 5 large free range eggs  
 4 sausages  
 100g breadcrumbs  
 1 bunch fresh chives  
 1/2 bunch fresh flat leaf parsley  
 1 whole nutmeg, for grating  
 Small bag of salad

Bring in 50p for:  
 1 tsp mustard  
 1 tsp brownedish  
 Plain flour, for dusting  
 Vegetable oil for frying  
 Salt and pepper
